### Qualifications:

The applicant should also have experience working with children/youth who have physical and/or mental disabilities. First Aid skills are an asset (or willing to obtain).

### Job Description:

- work one-on-one to provide individualized support for campers with special needs
- work with the Recreation Leaders to adapt and plan suitable activities to meet the specific needs of your campers
- work as a team with the other Special Needs Leader and Recreation Leaders
- undergo training in areas of behaviour management, First Aid, conflict resolution, etc.
- assist in registration
- help assemble supplies and maintain appropriate inventory
- supervise children in recreation activities, manage behaviours of children within the group
- attend weekly staff meetings
- evaluate the program
